Actors, dancers, and musicians entertain audiences by telling stories and creating experiences that make people feel different emotions.


Designers


Food and Culinary Careers

Develop new food products and ensure they're safe and nutritious


Restaurant Owners

Public service careers focus on helping communities and making our country work better! These important jobs range from emergency responders who keep us safe to scientists who research diseases at government laboratories. Public servants often feel great satisfaction knowing their work improves people's lives and solves important problems.

On our public service day, you'll participate in a mock city council meeting, design a new playground for a local park, and learn how emergency services respond to different situations. You'll see how government jobs offer meaningful ways to serve others and make positive changes in society!


Business and Entrepreneurship

Learning Through Experience

Job Shadowing

Spending time watching what a professional does during their workday to understand their responsibilities and challenges. Many companies offer special shadow days for students.

Volunteering

Helping organizations while gaining skills and experience. Even young people can volunteer at animal shelters, community gardens, or special events to learn about different fields.

Classes and Clubs

Joining after-school programs, summer camps, and community classes to explore interests like coding, cooking, robotics, or environmental science in a structured way.

Informational Interviews

Talking with professionals about their careers, asking questions about what they like about their job, how they got started, and what advice they have for someone interested in that field.

One of the best ways to learn about careers is through real-world experiences! Reading about jobs is helpful, but actually seeing and trying activities related to different careers gives you a much better understanding of what they're really like. Hands-on experiences can also help you discover interests you didn't know you had!

During our camp, we'll practice different ways to gain career experiences that you can continue using even after camp ends. Remember that many successful adults tried several different paths before finding the career that was right for them - exploration is an important part of the journey!
