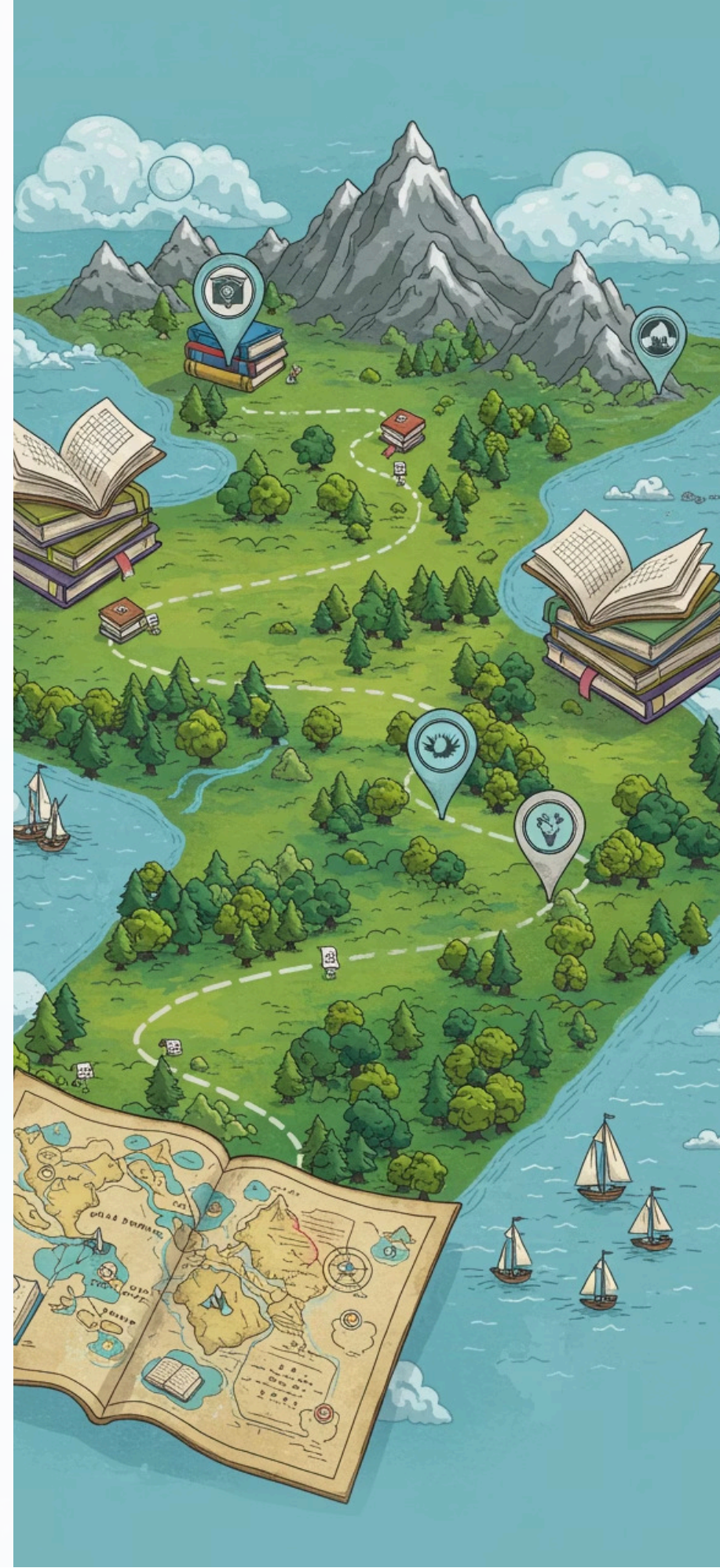

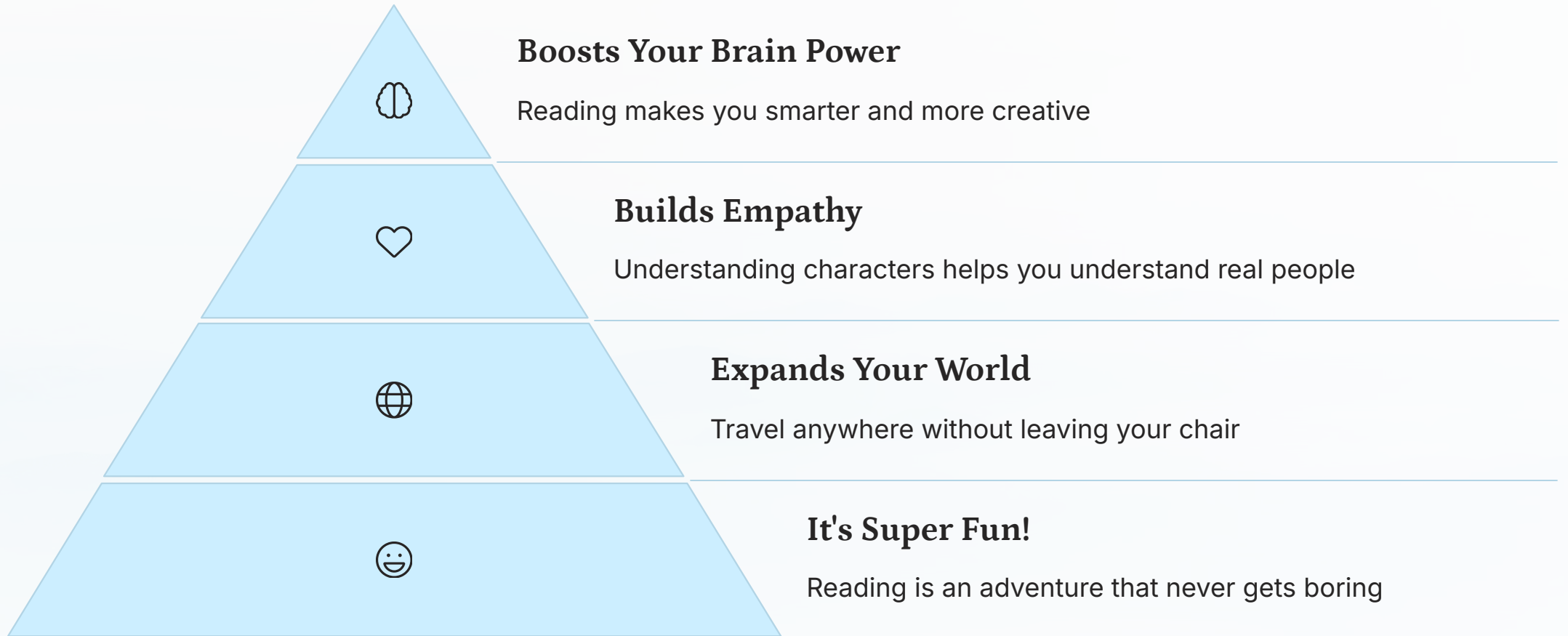

Why Reading Makes You Awesome

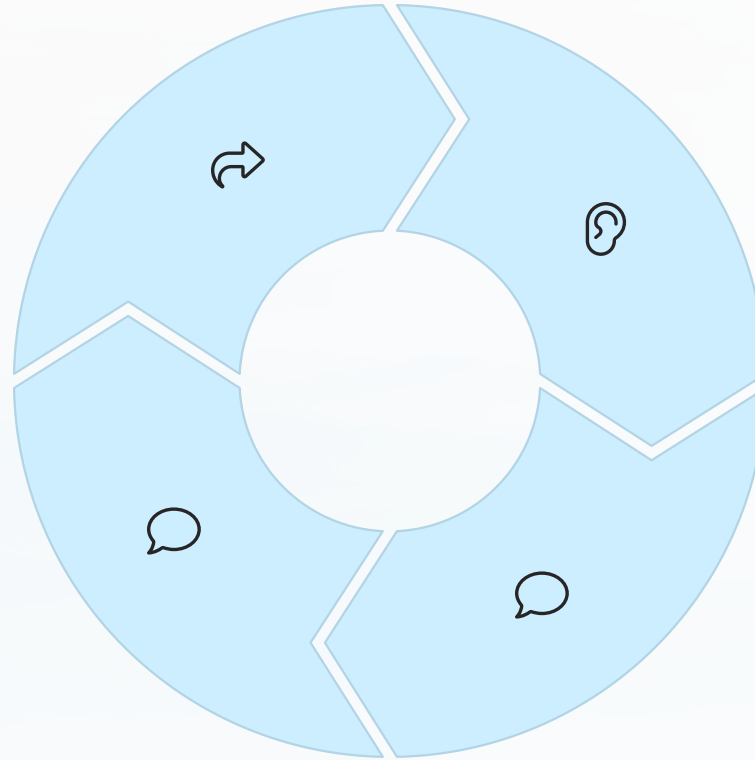

Genre Explorer

Read books from 5 different genres like mystery, science fiction, fantasy, history, and biography. Mark each one on your challenge card and share which genre surprised you the most!

Reading Marathon

Challenge yourself to read for 20 minutes every day. Keep track with our special Book Buddies reading log and celebrate when you reach your weekly goals!

Character Detective

Find a book character who reminds you of yourself or someone you know. Share with your group why this character feels familiar and what qualities you recognize.

Our reading challenges make books even more exciting! You'll discover new types of stories, build strong reading habits, and connect books to your real life. Everyone can participate at their own level, and counselors will help you find just-right books for your age and interests.

Your Reading Superhero Kit

Bookmark Collection

Cressida Cowell's adventure series shows that true strength comes from wisdom and understanding, not just physical power.

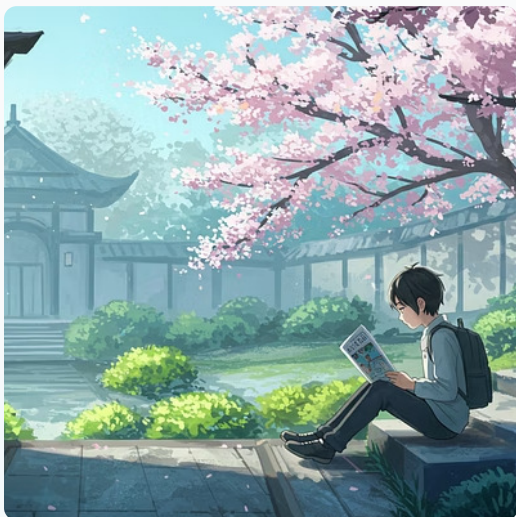


Diary of a Wimpy Kid

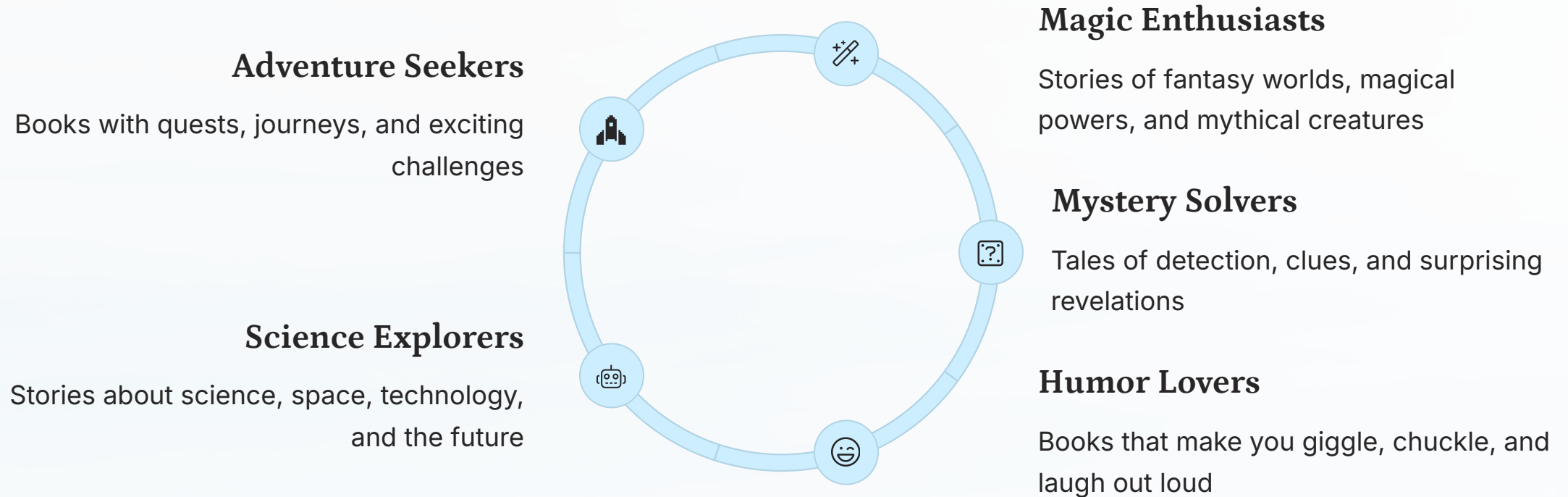

Monitor your reading minutes with our fun tracking system! For every 20 minutes you read, add a colorful link to our camp reading chain. Watch it grow longer each day as everyone contributes their reading time.



Celebration Time

When we reach our camp-wide reading goal of 10,000 minutes, we'll have a special celebration with treats, games, and reading-themed activities. Every participant receives a certificate and a small prize!

Our Read-a-thon Challenge brings the whole camp together with one big goal: to collectively read for 10,000 minutes during our time together! It's not a competition between campers – it's about working together to achieve something amazing as a team.

Power up Your Reading Speed



Use Your Finger as a Guide

Run your finger under the words as you read to help your eyes move smoothly across the page. This simple trick can increase your reading speed by up to 25%!



Time Yourself

Set a timer for one minute and see how many words you can read. Practice this regularly and watch your word count grow over time.



Minimize Distractions

Find a quiet spot where you can concentrate fully on your book. Turn off electronics and let your brain focus completely on the words.



Regular Practice

Like any skill, reading gets better with practice! Try to read at least 20 minutes every day to build your reading muscles.

Did you know you can train yourself to read faster while still understanding everything? During camp, we'll practice fun speed reading techniques that help your brain process words more quickly. The more you read, the faster and better you'll get!

Book Character Costume Day

One of the most exciting days at Book Buddies Camp is our Book Character Costume Day! You'll get to dress up as your favorite character from any book and share why you chose them. Our costume workshop will help you create amazing outfits using simple materials like cardboard, fabric scraps, and face paint.

Based on previous years, fantasy heroes like Harry Potter and Percy Jackson are the most popular choices, followed by funny characters like Greg Heffley and Junie B. Jones. Animal characters, historical figures from biographies, and science fiction characters round out the top choices. What character will you become?

Building Your Home Reading Nook



Comfort First

Pile up pillows, blankets, and soft seating to create a spot where you can read comfortably for long periods. Your body should feel relaxed so your mind can focus on the story.



Good Lighting

Position your nook near natural light or add a reading lamp that shines directly on your pages without creating glare. Proper lighting prevents eye strain during reading sessions.



Books Within Reach

Arrange your books nearby so you can easily swap one book for another. Consider organizing them by genre, series, or color to make selection fun and easy.



Minimize Distractions

Choose a quiet location away from TVs, video games, and high-traffic areas of your home. Some readers enjoy soft background music or nature sounds.

Continue your reading journey after camp by creating a special reading spot at home! A personal reading nook gives you a dedicated space for book adventures and signals to your brain that it's time to focus on reading when you settle in. During craft time, we'll design plans for the perfect reading nook that you can build when you return home.

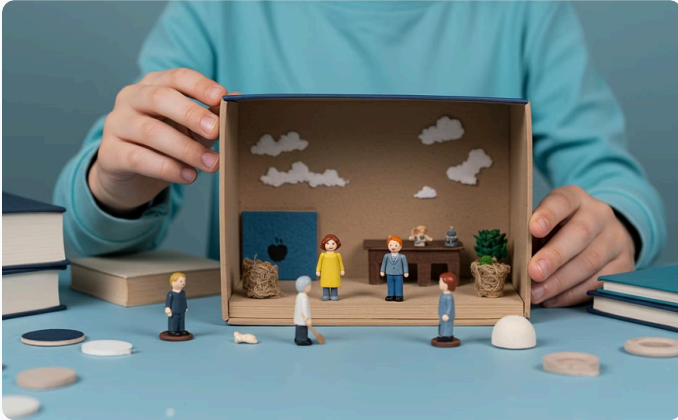
Family Reading Night Ideas

Theme Night	Everyone reads books related to a theme (space, animals, history) and shares interesting facts they learned
Read Aloud Rotation	Each family member takes turns reading a chapter from a shared book
Book & Movie	Read a book together, then watch the movie adaptation and discuss the differences
Author Spotlight	Everyone reads different books by the same author and compares writing styles
Reading Picnic	Spread a blanket indoors or outdoors with snacks and books for a special reading time

Reading becomes even more magical when shared with family! At camp, we'll create a Family Reading Night kit for you to take home, complete with activity cards, discussion question prompts, and ideas for making reading a fun family tradition.

Studies show that children who regularly read with their families develop stronger reading skills and enjoy books more throughout their lives. Plus, reading together creates wonderful memories and inside jokes that your family will treasure for years to come.

Book Report Alternatives



Scene Diorama

Create a 3D scene from your favorite part of the book inside a shoebox. Use craft materials, small toys, and your imagination to bring the setting to life in miniature form.



Comic Strip Retelling

Transform your book into a comic strip with colorful panels showing the main events of the story. Add speech bubbles to include important dialogue from the characters.



Video Book Review

Film yourself talking about the book like a YouTube reviewer! Share what you liked, your favorite characters, and whether you'd recommend it to other kids your age.

Traditional book reports can sometimes feel boring, but sharing what you've read should be fun! At camp, we'll explore creative alternatives that let you express your thoughts about books in exciting ways. These projects help you think deeply about what you've read while letting your creativity shine.
